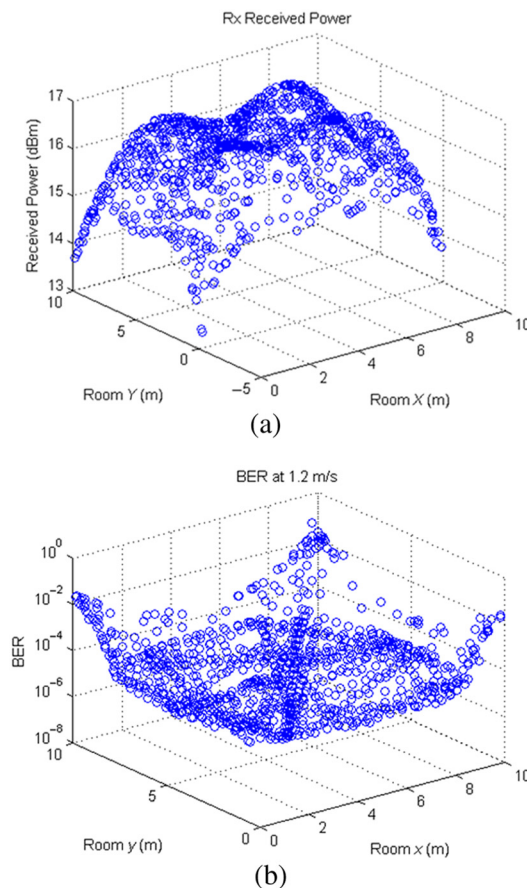


Fig. 8 The random direction mobility model with the user's speed of 1.2 m/s: (a) the positioning error and (b) BER at 1.2 m/s.

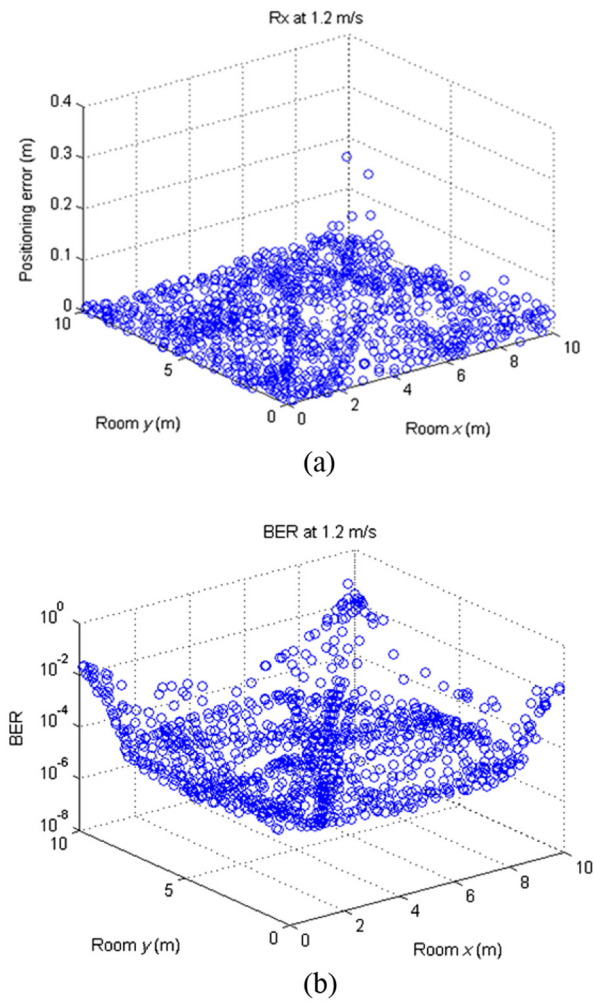


Fig. 8 The random direction mobility model with the user's speed of 1.2 m/s: (a) the positioning error and (b) BER at 1.2 m/s.
